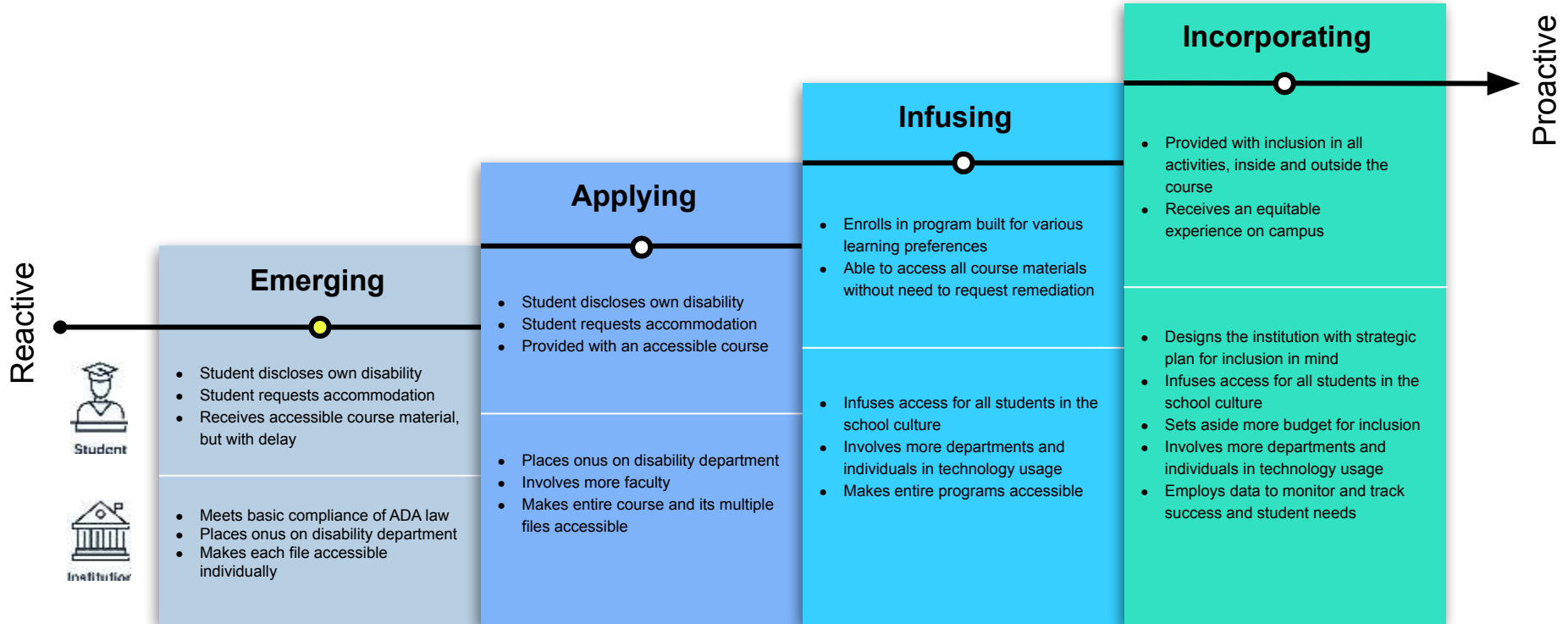

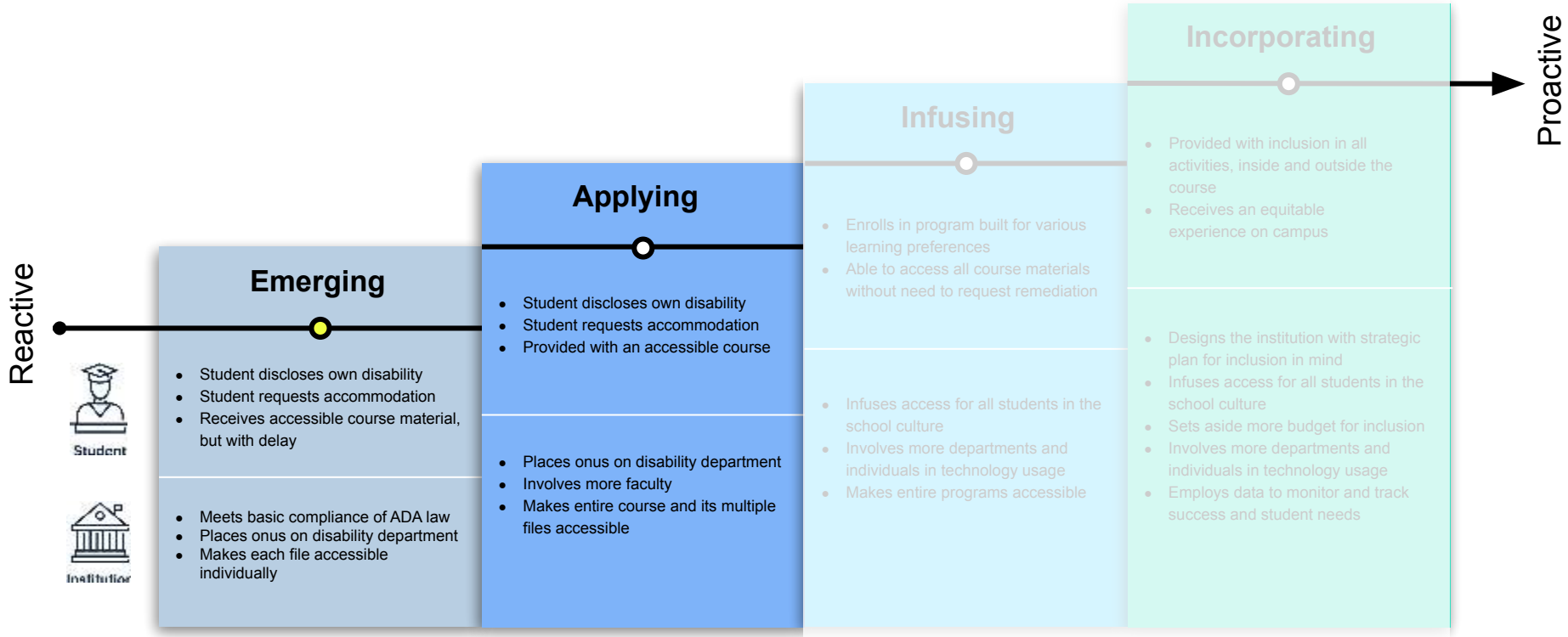

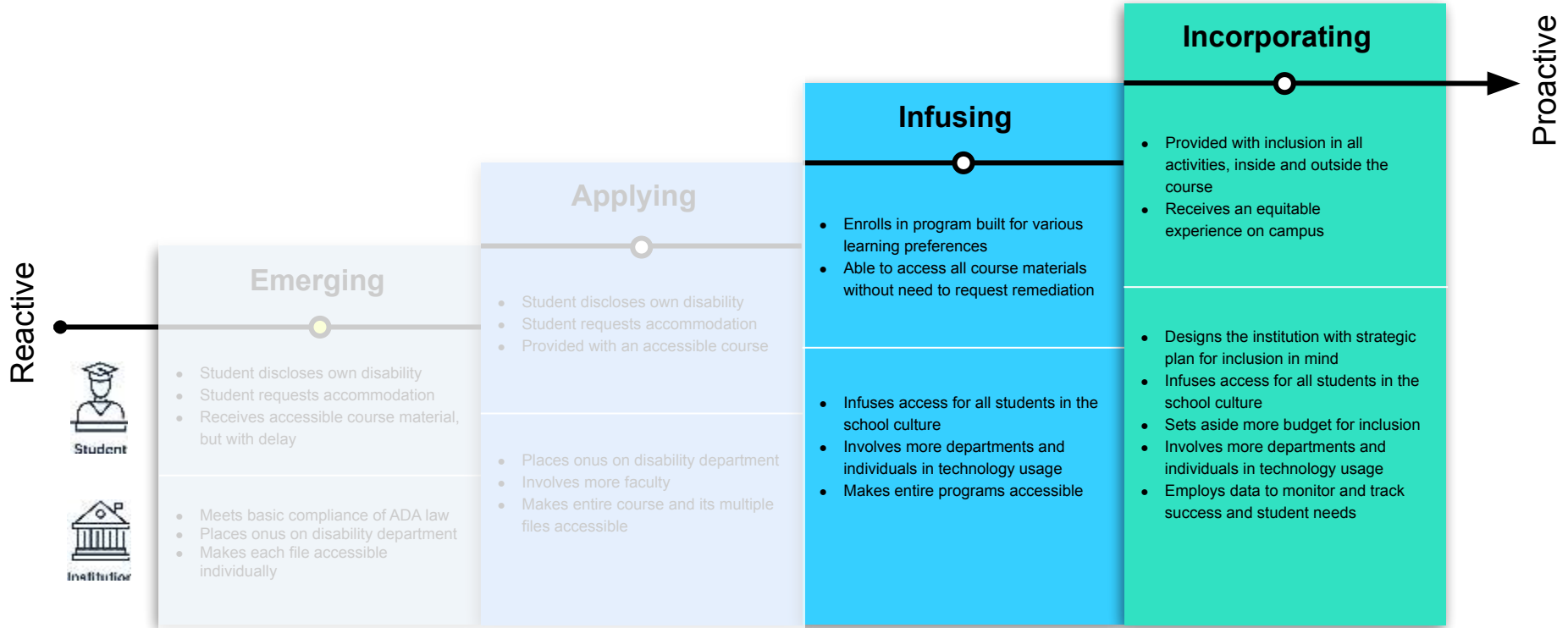
The Maturity Model is developed to **communicate** and **categorize** access within a higher education institution as defined by the stages.



The stages are based on the **culture** and **operational practice** throughout the institution in providing their students and employees with access.





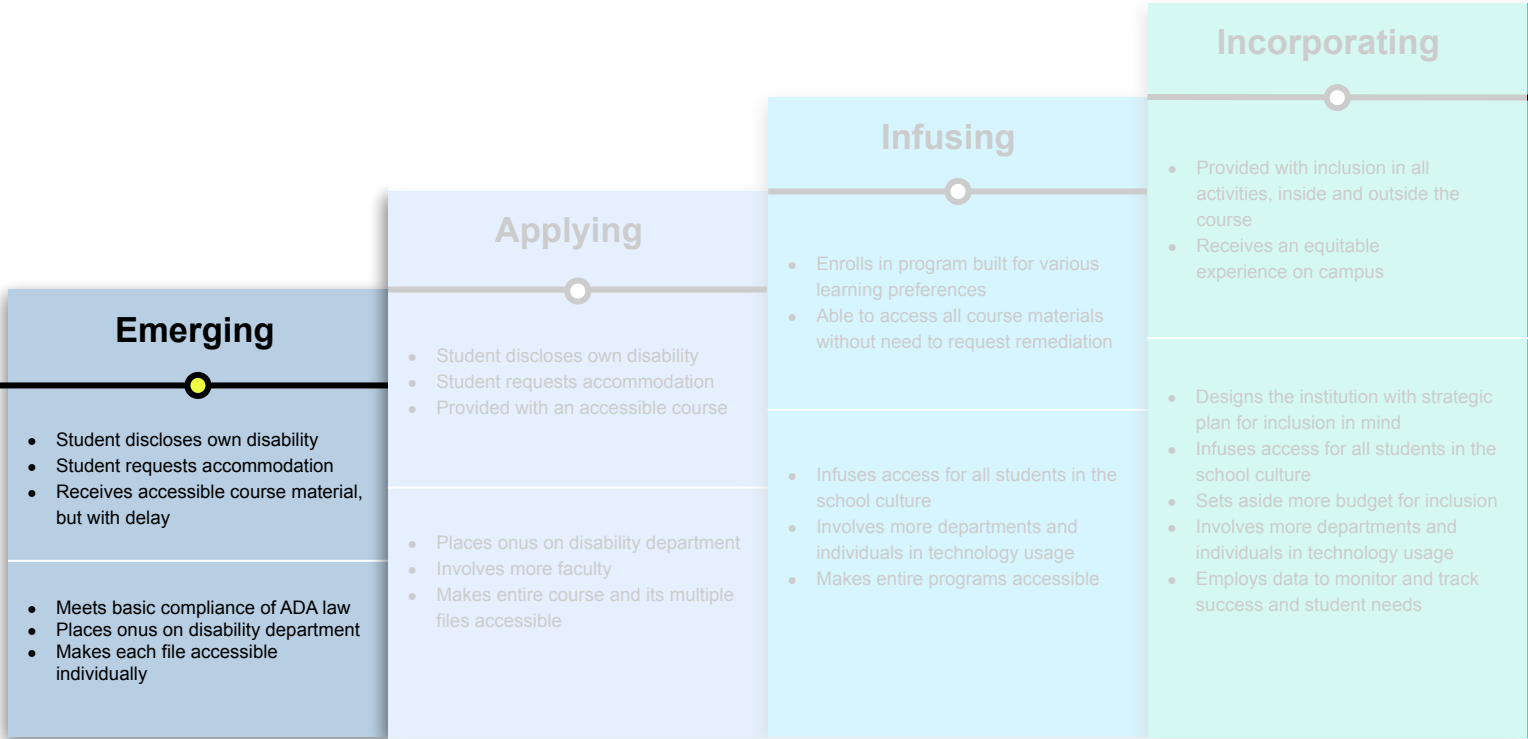

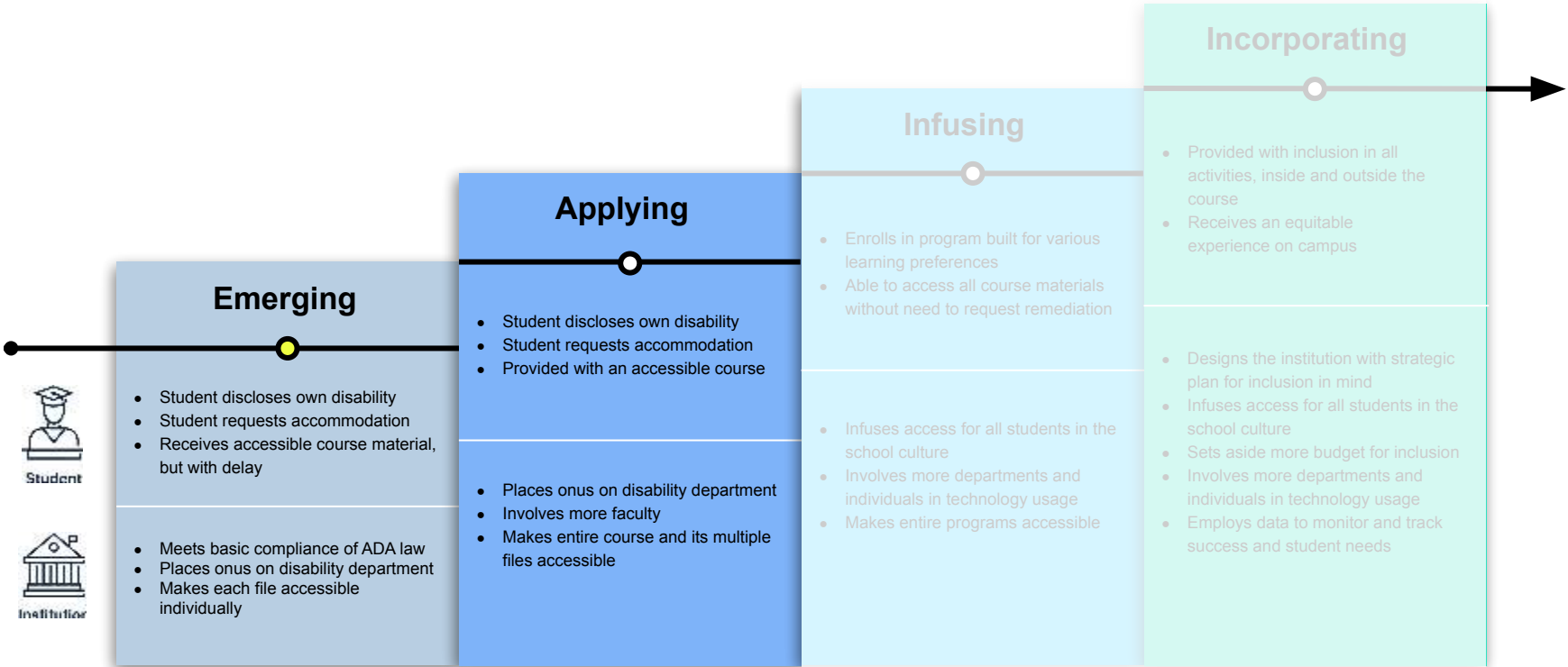

Infusing Stage - Points to Consider

- **Palmer is able to engage with course content in an equitable way to her classmates.**
- **The majority of work required from the instructors and DSS in preparing the content occurs prior to the start of a semester and can therefore be planned for.**
- **The captioned content is still only made available to Palmer.**





Captions were no longer considered an accommodation feature, but are now recognized as a **learning feature**.

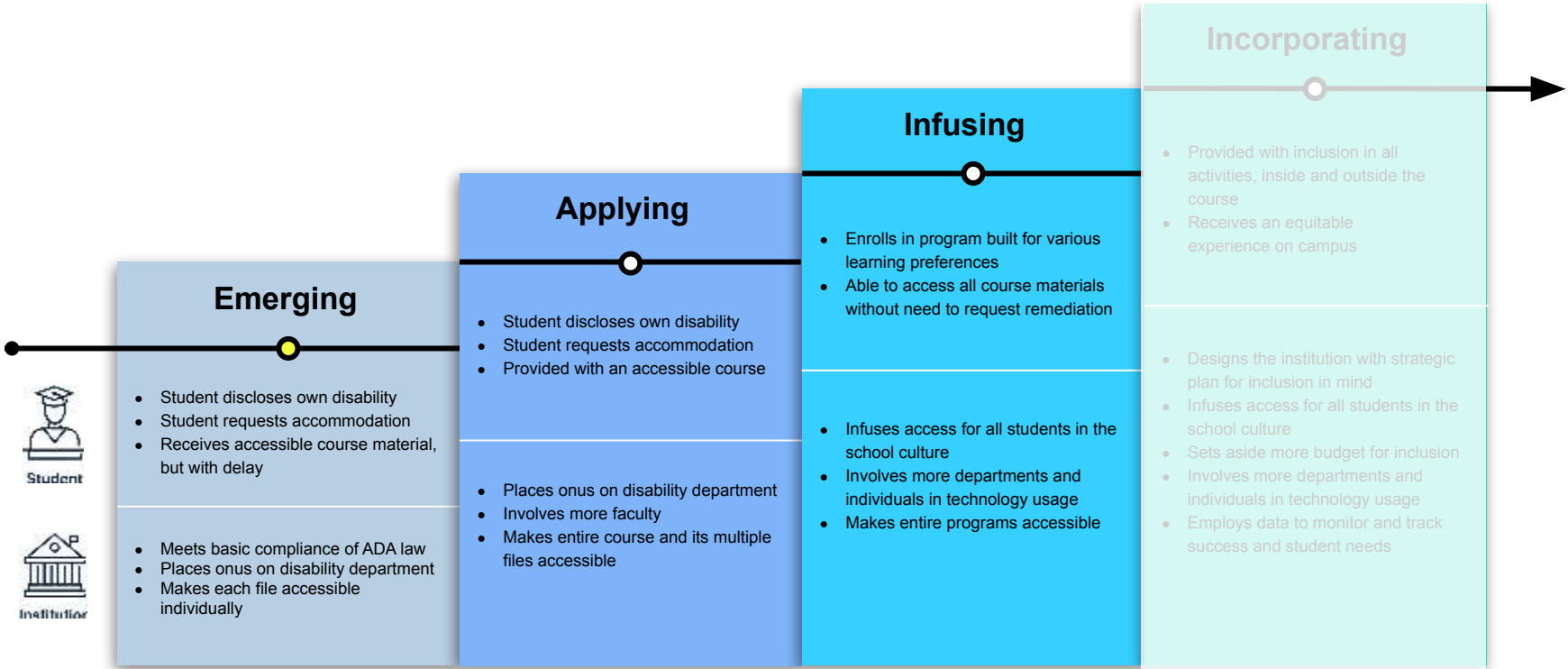

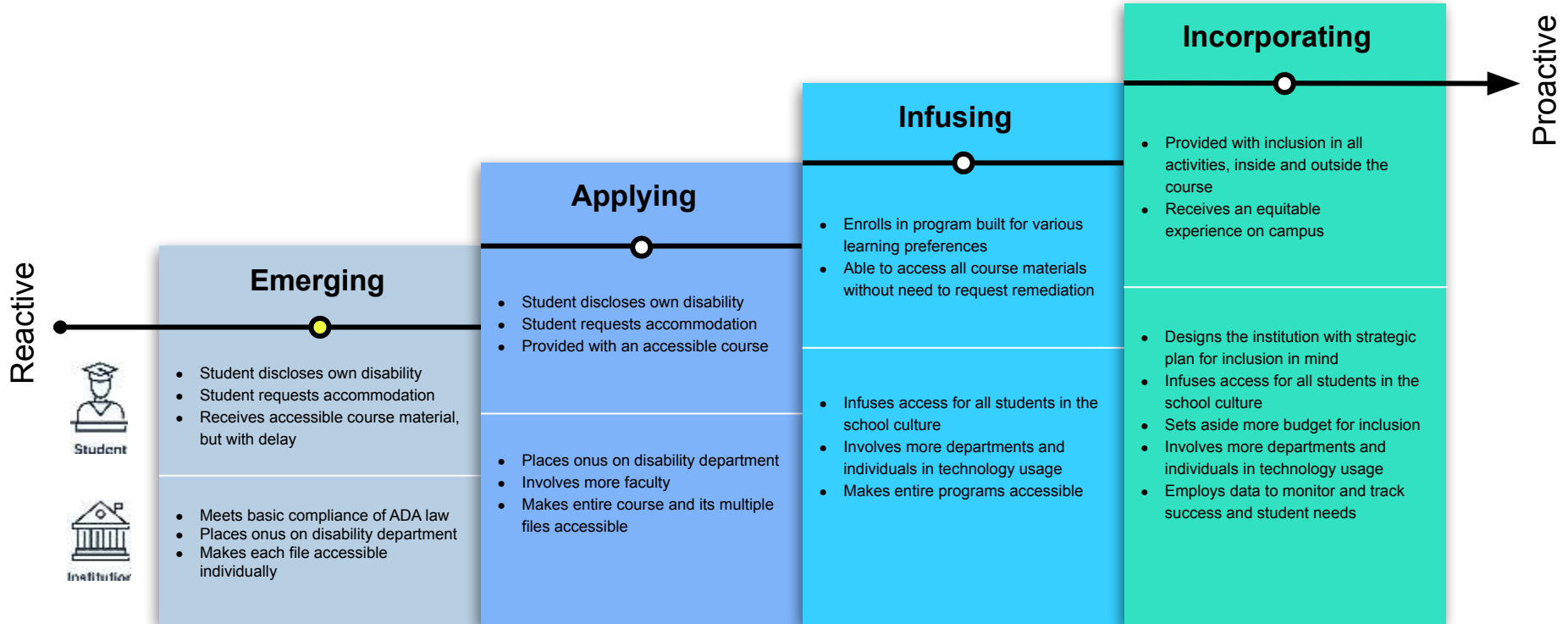
